REGISTRATION

Participants can register online in teams of two, three, four, five or six. The \$5 entrance fee into the Hunt includes participation in Growing Up In the Valley's Family Excursion and admittance into the Post-Hunt Party at Roanoke Catholic School. Registration starts at 10 am.

The Hunt starts after you check-in. Teams can begin reporting back by 3 pm but must be in by 4 pm. The Post-Hunt Party will end at 5 pm. Teams that wish to register and start late may do so but still have a deadline of 4 pm for Post-Hunt check-in.

TEAM CAPTAIN

Each team captain will be given one marker that needs to be present in all photos. Check in at the end of the race will be under team captain/one person. Team captain will be accepting the prize on behalf of the winning team. Team Captain must be at least 18 years old.

GENERAL RULES

Team members need to stay with their team at all times. You may not split up to divide scavenger hunt takes or pay or bride additional individuals to join your team and complete your tasks. The Team Marker must be present in all photos.

It's very important to be kind and respectful with strangers, and with that said – always be on guard and stay safe, use your healthy judgment when it comes to people you don't know.

All challenges must be completed and picture scenes must be taken only during the duration of this specific scavenger hunt (challenges completed or photo/videotaping scenarios taken outside this time frame will be disqualified).

While teams are driving around in a car, everyone needs to wear appropriate seat belts. Make sure each team has a mobile phone and contact numbers in case of an emergency. No littering. Always clean up after yourselves and your teammates. Judges' determinations after the Treasure Hunt are final.

Teams must be courteous and respectful to their teammates and all the outside people involved in the Treasure Hunt. NO harassing citizens of your town, physically or verbally for items or photographs. It is their right to choose not to help you.

No breaking any laws! Scavenger hunts are for having fun, but you must do so legally! Please obey all traffic laws during the event. If you break any laws during the duration of the scavenger hunt, your team will be disqualified. This includes (but is not limited to) – shoplifting, assault, trespassing, blackmail, forgery, perjury, fraud, etc.
